



Bisley National meeting 2026

Home countries Selection

The WSRA intends to enter teams to represent Wales in the Home countries match this year at Bisley National meeting, held on Friday 28th August on Century range, in the afternoon.

All teams are to be made up from the WSRA membership, as confirmed by submission of membership form and membership fee – prior to the day of international competition.

The teams will be selected and entered to the NSRA by David Phelps (Coach).

Senior Team of 10

This team can be made up from men, ladies, and juniors subject to fulfilling the criteria listed below.

Nominated Captain – Nominated Secretary –

The team shall be made up from the top scoring individuals, as listed by the NSRA stats, in championship aggregate – Competition 7. To provide the most competitive international team, the person selecting the team may seed into the team up to 3 Shooters, who for whatever reason, have not been able to complete the championship aggregate – Competition 7.

Ladies team of 5

This team is to be made up of ladies, or junior Ladies subject to fulfilling the criteria listed below.

Nominated Captain – Nominated Secretary –

It is important to note that being able to enter a team is the primary goal. A Prospective team, including reserves will be selected ahead of the Bisley national meeting, being made up of those responding members who are either committed to attending the meeting or who will commit to attend for the match. If day attendance selection occurs, we would ask those individuals to compete in the Lord Earl Roberts Match on the Friday morning to attune to Dewar competition at Bisley.

Men's team of 5

This team is to be made up of Men, or junior Men subject to fulfilling the criteria listed below.

Nominated Captain – Nominated Secretary –

The team shall be made up from the top scoring Men, as listed by the NSRA stats, in championship aggregate – Competition 7. To provide the most competitive international team, the person selecting the team may seed into the team up to 2 Shooters, who for whatever reason, have not been able to complete the championship aggregate – Competition 7.

Junior team of 3

This team is to be made up of Junior Ladies or Junior Men as defined by the NSRA age rules and subject to fulfilling the criteria listed below.

Nominated Captain – Nominated Secretary –
